### **Updates on programming; building links to other EU external financing instruments**

This meeting has been organised as a follow-up to the Civil Society Dialogue Network (CSDN) Funding Instruments Meeting which took place in September 2013 in Brussels.<sup>1</sup>

The purpose of this meeting is for the European Commission (EC) and the European External Action Service (EEAS) to provide an update on the Instrument contributing to Stability and Peace (IcSP) Strategy Paper (SP) 2014-2020 and Multiannual Indicative Programme (MIP) 2014-2017, and to present the IcSP 2014 annual action programmes (AAPs).

It will also provide an opportunity to introduce a broader discussion about support for peacebuilding and conflict prevention under the other EU external financing instruments<sup>2</sup> in the context of the recent joint EC-EEAS communication on the EU's comprehensive approach to external conflicts and crises.<sup>3</sup>

It is envisaged that this preliminary exchange of views will facilitate the identification of key issues relating to support for peacebuilding and conflict prevention under the other EU external financing instruments which could be further discussed in a dedicated CSDN Funding Instruments Meeting later in the year.

#### **Civil Society Dialogue Network**

The Civil Society Dialogue Network (CSDN) is a three-year project co-financed by the European Union (Instrument for Stability) and aimed at facilitating dialogue on peacebuilding issues between civil society and EU policy-makers. It is managed by the European Peacebuilding Liaison Office (EPLO), in co-operation with the European Commission and the European External Action Service.
