- Budget allocated (AAPs 2010-2014): **€39.5 Million**
- **Recurrent priorities** under AAPs 2010 to 2014 for CSOs' capacity building:
 - Mediation & Dialogue: 42% of funds allocated;
 - WPS: 35% of funds;
 - Children & Youth: 20% of funds
 - Other issues: media, CSR/Natural resources

- Indicative 2015 budget: **€25 Million**
- In line with IcSP Strategy Paper's priority areas for Article 4 and MIP 2014-2017
- Projected timeline for AAP adoption:
 - End Nov. 2014: consultations with EU services and partners
 - Jan.2015: AAP drafting
 - March 2015: InterService Consultation; Comitology
 - March 2015: adoption

KEY IDEAS

- Continued support to in-country civil society actors in conflict prevention, crisis preparedness and peace-building (*Sub Delegated Calls*)

=> Potential priorities:

- Youth and peace including inter-confessional dialogue;
- Social media and conflict;
- WPS/gender budgeting;
- Reintegration of child soldiers

- Support in the field of natural resources and conflicts/conflict minerals.
- Continued support to civil society's capacities on early warning and conflict analysis



- 2nd phase of cooperation with the League of Arab States in the fields of crisis preparedness and crisis response.
- 2nd phase of the European Union Police Services Training (EUPST) – civilian missions
- Continued support in the field of Post Conflict Needs Assessment and Post Disaster Needs Assessment
