

Check-list for root causes of conflict: Country Conflict Assessment (CCA)

Welcome to the on-line Country Conflict Assessment (CCA) data entry.
From this site you can complete the check-list of root causes of conflict for your country.

The check-list is subdivided into ten problem areas. For each of these areas, several specific problems are identified. You will be asked whether these problems apply or not to the country you are responsible for. Then you are asked the extent to which you agree or disagree to a statement concerning the country situation for a specific problem area.

In case you agree (somewhat or strongly) to one of the statements, you will be asked:

- to identify the trend of the problem (improving/ stable/worsening);
- to describe significant developments / events related to the problem;
- to list relevant EU and / or International Community action to address the problem.

These additional questions are important, as they will allow for a better assessment of the country conflict risk.

The Head of Delegation can assign the head of political section to complete the on-line questionnaire, after which the submission can be reviewed and authorised by the Head of Delegation electronically. Involvement of the Operations section and other relevant sections is important and encouraged. Where they are present, the involvement of CSDP missions and / or ECHO field offices is similarly encouraged.

The exercise does not require additional research - the aim is to systematise existing knowledge.
