IcSP Programmable mid-long-term actions

Conflict prevention, peacebuilding, crisis preparedness (Art. 4)

- a) Early warning and conflictsensitive risk analysis;
- b) Confidence-building, mediation, dialogue and reconciliation;
- c) Capacity-building for participation in civilian stabilisation missions
- d) Post-conflict and post-disaster recovery
- e) Natural resources and conflicts

Global, trans-regional and emergnig threats (Art. 5)

- a) Preventing and Countering terrorism
- b) Fighting Organised crime
- c) Protecting Critical infrastructures
- d) Mitigation and preparedness against chemical, biological, radiological and nuclear risks
- e) Security threats emanating from Climate change

Since 2017 Capacity building in support of development and security for development CBSD for art. 4 and 5



Continuity with the IcSP

- All IcSP priorities confirmed in the NDICI with new areas of intervention
- Partnership with Civil Society organisation
- Mix of global and local approach
- Flexibility whenever possible
- Multilateralism and partnership with international organisations



New challenges

- New global and trans-regional challenges: terrorism, climate change, global disinformation, cyber security
- More inclusive (women, youth, minorities) and conflict sensitive approach
- Increased need for coordination and complementarity (EU, EU MS, EU partners)
- Partnership with the Civil Society
- Strategic multilateral approach and partnership with international and regional organisations in changed and changing geopolitical scenarios
