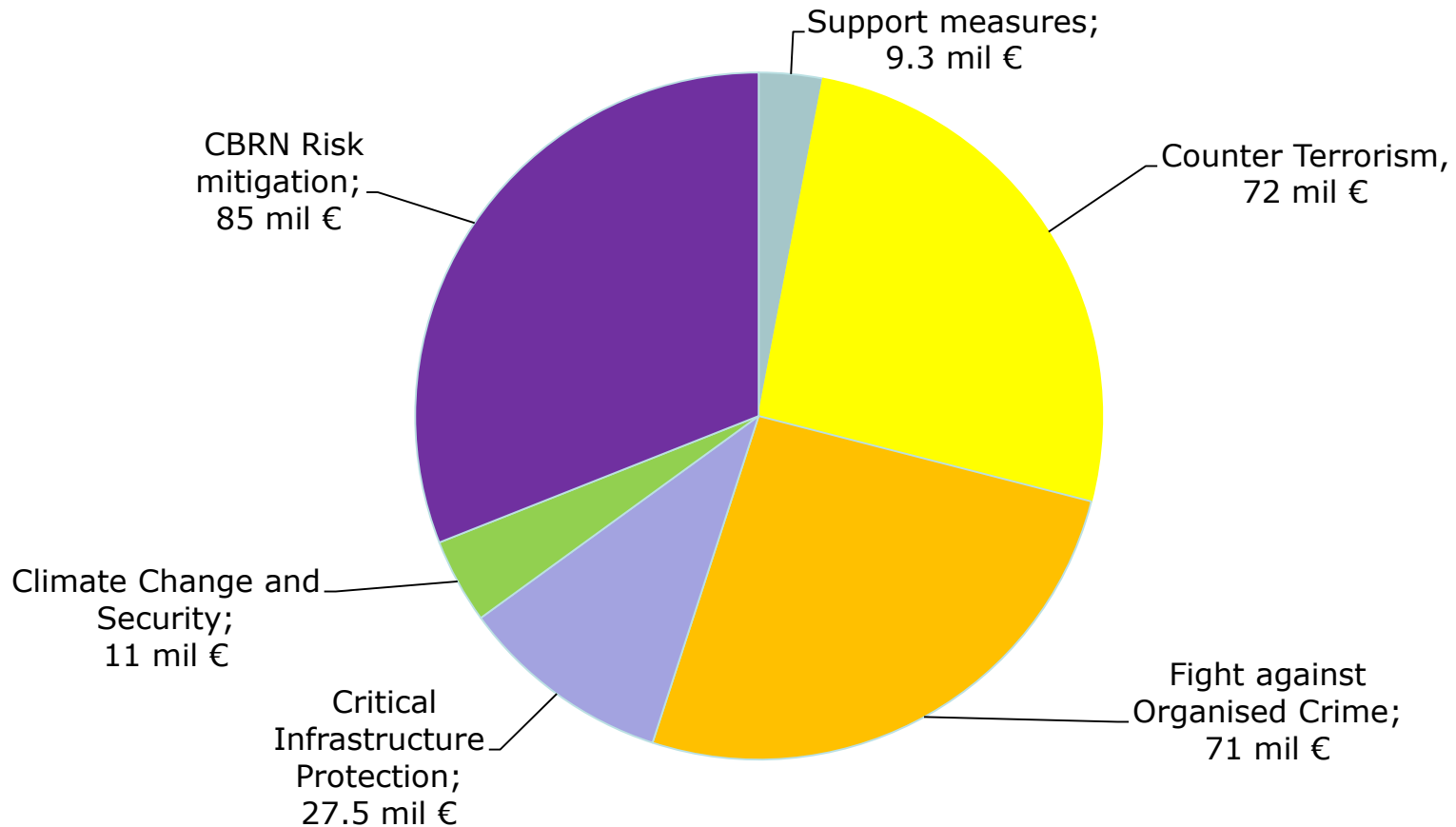

# IcSP Article 5 (2014-2017)

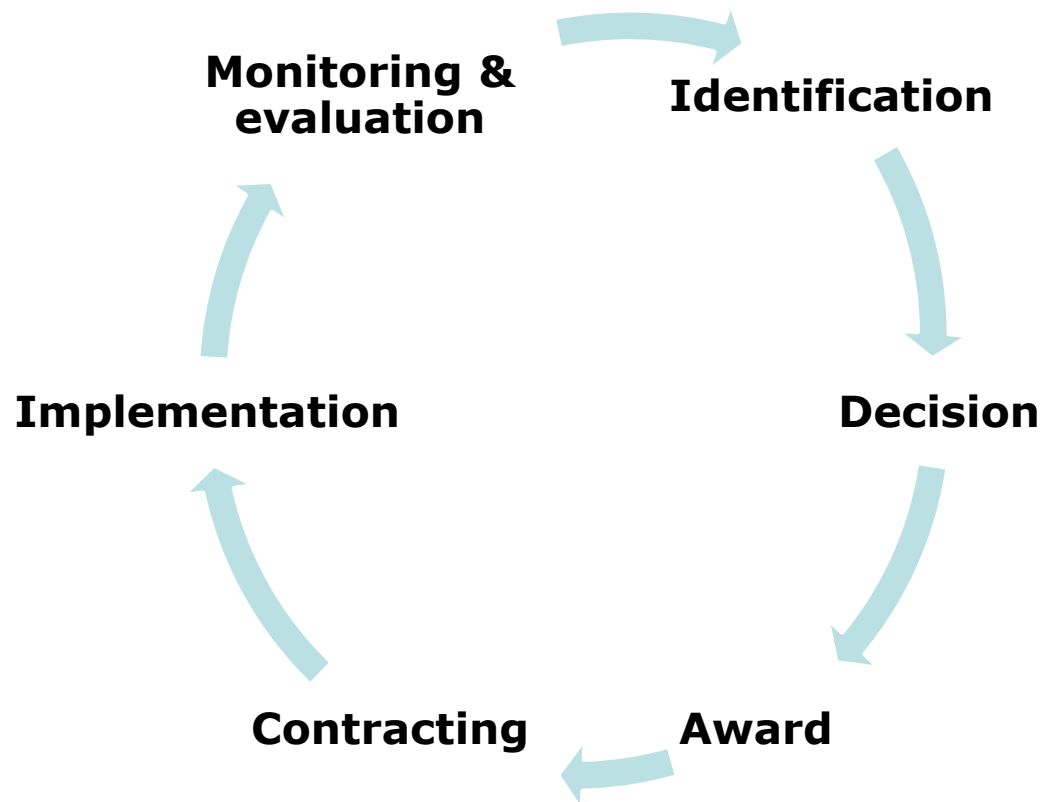
