The specific objectives are to:

- Discuss common challenges and opportunities faced by peacebuilding practitioners;
- Discuss the way forward for the EU and what role for civil society organisations.

It is managed by the European Peacebuilding Liaison Office (EPLO), a civil society network, in co-operation with the European Commission (EC) and the European External Action Service (EEAS).
