

EU Update: October 2023

Council of the EU

In September, the Council imposed a <u>tenth package of sanctions</u> on individuals and entities responsible for serious human rights violations in **Iran**, <u>new sanctions</u> on individuals responsible for serious human rights violations in **Russia** and in the **occupied Ukrainian territories**, and <u>prolonged existing sanctions</u> targeting those responsible for undermining or threatening the territorial integrity, sovereignty and independence of **Ukraine** until 15 March 2024.

On 25 September, the Council <u>adopted an assistance measure</u> under the **European Peace** Facility (EPF) worth €11.75 million to support the **Beninese Armed Forces** with intelligence, surveillance and reconnaissance (ISR) aircraft and unmanned air systems.

European Commission (EC)

On 18 September, the EC released €5.2 million to support **Libya** in the aftermath of the floods.

On 20 September, the EC <u>released</u> €140 million to support basic needs and livelihoods in the fields of education, health, agriculture and women's economic empowerment in **Afghanistan**.

On 26 September, the EC <u>adopted</u> a humanitarian assistance package worth €5 million in response to the increasing needs resulting from the **Nagorno-Karabakh** crisis.

European Parliament (EP)

The EP had a plenary session on 11-14 September in Strasbourg. Members <u>adopted resolutions</u> on the <u>relations with Belarus</u>, <u>Guatemala</u>, and the human rights situation in <u>Bangladesh</u>.
